Services

- Start Buprenorphine (Suboxone) to get off heroin or fentanyl or pain pills

- Get medications to help with alcohol or methamphetamine

- Harm reduction supplies (Naloxone, safe injection kits, etc....)

-Hepatitis C treatment

-Linkage to HIV treatment/preventative care

-Ask about "the shot"

- 30-day suboxone injection

(Sublocade)

**also offer 30-day vivitrol injection*

for alcohol use disorder.
